- Required to file Schedule D for capital gains.

Note: If you filed a 1040 only to claim American Opportunity, Hope or Lifetime Learning credits, and you would have otherwise been eligible for a 1040A or 1040EZ, answer "Yes" to this question.

If you filed a 1040 and were not required to file a tax return, answer "Yes" to this question.
